Check out **Animation Gets Real Miami**: a summer camp for teens and young adults on the autism spectrum. Or, immerse your child in color through a unique painting adventure with **Zot Artz**.

Enjoy a theater, music, or museum experience in a judgement-free atmosphere with **Sensory-Friendly Programs** presented by Actors' Playhouse, Area Stage Company, Fantasy Theatre Factory, HistoryMiami, Miami Childrens Theater, New World Symphony, The Miami Children's Museum, and more. Featured annual AKI events include **Arts For Wellness Day**, promoting healing through the expressive arts, and the free **AKI Family Arts Festival**, a community festival day filled with interactive arts activities, live performances, giveaways, and community resources for parents.

AKI activities are created especially by experts with a proven track record for designing and implementing inclusive programs for children and youth with disabilities.
